GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP COURSE

A program that deepens understanding of global issues, diverse cultures, and shared responsibilities in an interconnected world. Through interdisciplinary learning and reflection, students build critical thinking, cultural awareness, and ethical responsibility as global citizens.

- Case Study Discussions on global issues (e.g., climate change, inequality, migration) to develop critical thinking and perspective-taking
- Cultural Exchange Sessions where students share traditions, values, and practices to build intercultural understanding
- Collaborative Group Projects focused on proposing solutions to real-world global challenges

ENGLISH SUMMER CAMP

An immersive language program that enhances English proficiency through interactive, culturally enriching activities. It combines communication-based learning, collaboration, and real-world application to build confidence across speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

- Interactive language workshops (grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation)
- Group discussions, debates, and role-playing exercises
- Team-based challenges and presentations
- Cultural exchange sessions and social immersion activities
- Games and creative tasks designed to reinforce language learning in a fun environment
