- Application: October 15 - 30
- Acceptance Letter: October 30 – Nov 10
- Orientation: January - 9

Third Quarter: September 7 – December 20

- Nomination: April 1 – May 10
- Application: May 1 – June 10
- Acceptance Letter: June 10 – 20
- Orientation: September 8

- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Letter of introduction
- Copy of valid international medical insurance
- Spanish proficiency certificate (may be waived by the home university)
