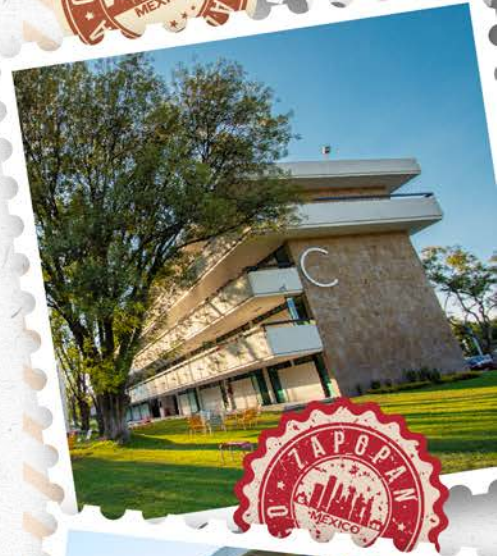

# APPLICATION PROCESS

## FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The first step to begin the process at UAG is for the International Exchange Office at the home university to send an email nominating the selected students with the following information:

- Full name
- Major
- Current semester
- Email
- Application period(s)

Please specify the agreement or partnership through which the exchange will take place. Once we receive this information, we will contact students directly via email, detailing the required documents, deadlines, and general regulations for applying to our program.

Results will be communicated within ten days of receiving the student's documentation.

It is important to note that students only have the first week of classes to make changes to their courses.

### Academic Requirements

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Since Spanish is our primary language of instruction, we recommend a B2 level of language proficiency. A certificate issued by the language department of the home university validating the student's language proficiency level will be accepted.

UAG does not recommend participating in an exchange during the final semester of the academic program, as the availability of the courses needed to fulfill academic requirements cannot be guaranteed.

### Visa

Students from certain countries who wish to study in Mexico for a period of less than 180 days do not require a student visa.
